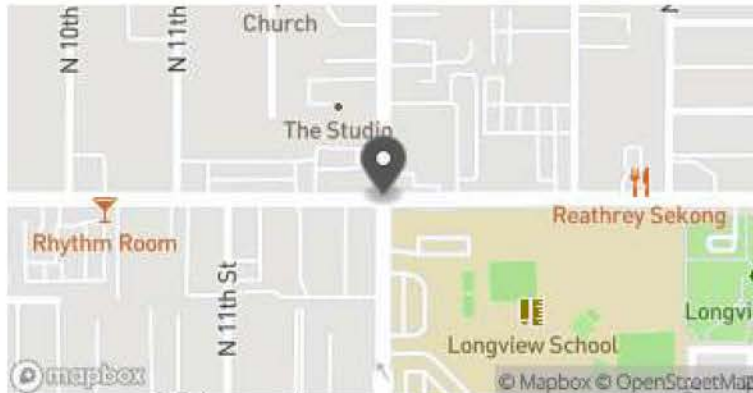

Incident Summary

On September 7th, 2021 at approximately 2138 hours, Officer O'Hayer #10647 was traveling westbound on East Indian School Road and North 12th Street in a fully marked police patrol Tahoe, unit #011782. He had just finished making an officer's back up, and was en route to a different emergency call. He was traveling a short distance behind another fully marked police patrol Tahoe who was en route to the same emergency call. After the first police Tahoe entered and passed the intersection of North 12th Street and East Indian School Road on a green light for east and west bound traffic, O'Hayer's Tahoe entered the same intersection. As he did so, a 2007 Mercury Grand Marquis turned northbound onto North 12th Street from the eastbound left-hand turn lane on East Indian School Road, failing to yield to the Tahoe. As the Mercury turned, it collided with the police Tahoe. After both vehicles came to rest, it was determined that the headlights on the police Tahoe were not activated. No injuries were reported, nor was Phoenix Fire Department requested. Both vehicles were driveable, however there was visible damage to the front of the Mercury and to the front and driver side of the Tahoe. It was later found that there was a temporary license plate for

the Mercury inside the passenger compartment, but had not been displayed. That temporary license plate is AZ.G8A2SD and is valid. O'Hayer was wearing his body worn camera, and it was activated during this incident.

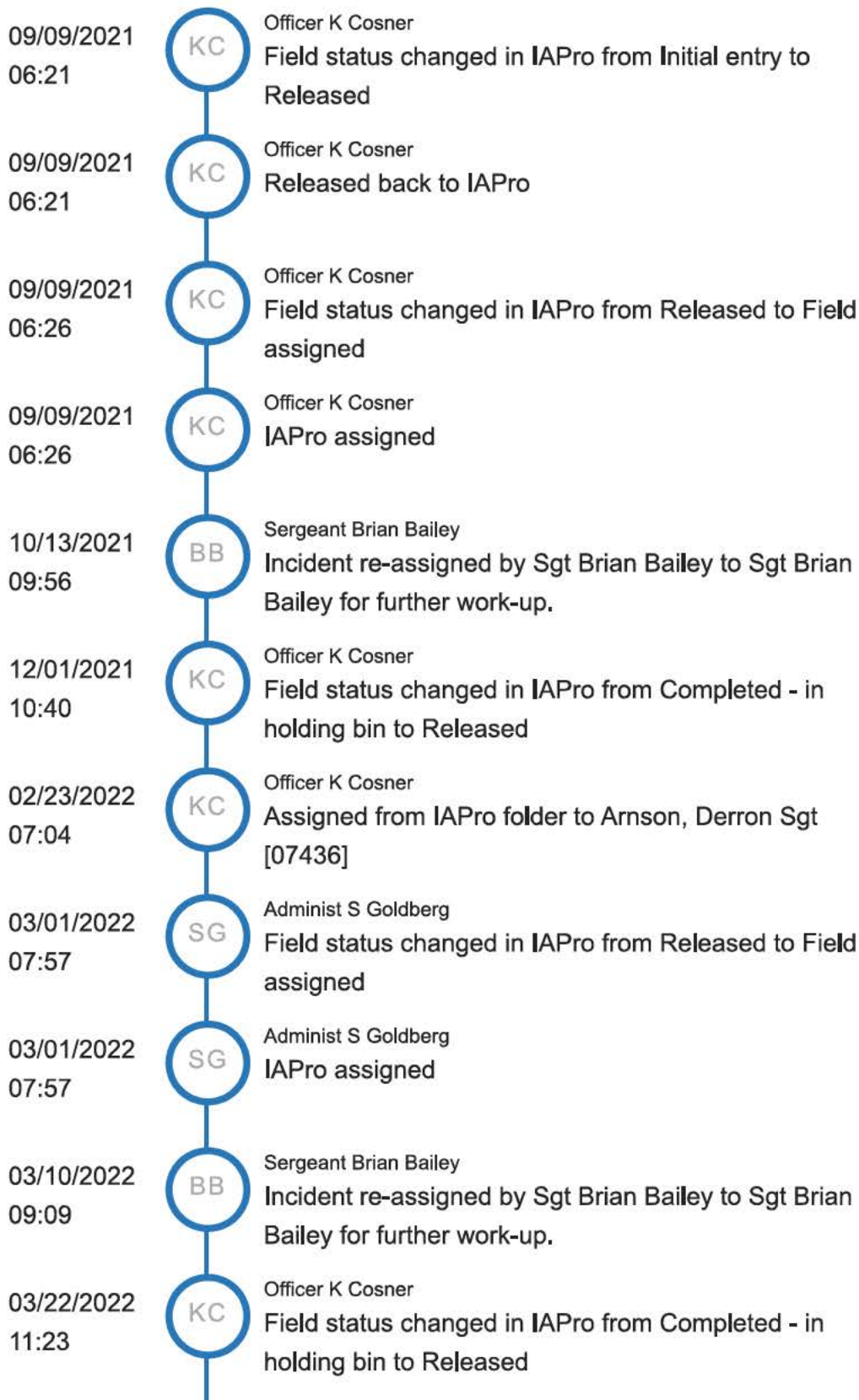
