The critical incident occurred December 27, 2020, at approximately 11:59 p.m. at North 27th Ave and West Indian School Road.

The Critical Incident Review board met on Tuesday, September 20, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the 4th Floor Chief's Conference Room at 620 W. Washington Street. The Board consisted of Chairperson / Assistant Chief Steve Martos, Commander Charles Consolian, Officer Dominick Roestenberg, Mr. Tom Eglin, Ms. Candice Fremouw, and Ms. AJ Marsden.
