ON 08-10-21 AT APPROXIMATELY 0053 HOURS, I WAS DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] TO ASSIST PATROL OFFICERS WITH A BURGLARY ALARM CALL AT A LARGE CONSTRUCTION SITE. THE CALL WAS FROM THE

MONITORING COMPANY WHO HAD VIDEO FOOTAGE ON THE FENCED IN PROPERTY UNDER CONSTRUCTION OF A SUSPECT GOING INTO AN APARTMENT UNDER CONSTRUCTION.

UPON MY ARRIVAL, I CONTACTED PATROL OFFICERS ON SCENE WHO ADVISED ME WHERE THEY WERE DIRECTED BY THE ALARM COMPANY TO THE DOOR THE SUSPECT WAS SEEN GOING INTO. THEY ALSO ADVISED ME THEY HAD BEEN GIVING NUMEROUS ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM THE OUTSIDE WHILE WAITING FOR ME TO ARRIVE. I CONTACTED THE RP THROUGH OUR RADIO WHO ADVISED NO ONE HAD PERMISSION TO BE ON THE PROPERTY, THEY WOULD PRESS CHARGES, AND THEY WERE GOOD WITH USING A CANINE TO SEARCH. I THEN ASSEMBLED THE LISTED SEARCH TEAM TO SEARCH THE PROPERTY. AT THE TIME OF MY DEPLOYMENT THE FOLLOWING WAS KNOWN TO ME THROUGH RADIO TRANSMISSIONS AND OFFICERS ON SCENE.

SEVERITY OF THE CRIME: BURGLARY OF A FENCED IN CONSTRUCTION SITE.  
DANGER THE SUSPECT POSED: THE SUSPECT IN THIS INCIDENT HAD GOTTEN THROUGH A FENCED IN PROPERTY WITH NUMEROUS CAMERAS AND NO TRESSPASSING SIGNS POSTED. IT WAS UNKNOWN IF THE SUSPECT HAD WEAPONS OR FOUND SOMETHING ON THE PROPERTY TO BE USED AS A WEAPON.  
HIDDEN SUSPECT AVOIDING ARREST: THE SUSPECT WAS POSSIBLY INSIDE A PARTIALLY CONSTRUCTED BUILDING HIDING. HE HAD NOT RESPONDED TO NUMEROUS ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE PATROL OFFICERS ON SCENE.

PRIOR TO STARTING MY SEARCH, JUST INSIDE THE GATE THAT WAS LOCKED, I MADE A LOUD AND CLEAR CANINE ANNOUNCEMENT. THE DOOR THE OFFICERS WERE DIRECTED TO FROM THAT LOCATION WAS APPROXIMATELY 20 YARDS AWAY. I STARTED MY SEARCH AND MOVED TOWARDS THAT OPEN DOOR OF THE PARTIALLY CONSTRUCTED APARTMENT. AS POLICE SERVICE DOG RALPH AND THE TEAM CAME TO THE ENTRANCE, I OBSERVED A BEHAVIORAL CHANGE IN RALPH INDICATING TO ME HE WAS WORKING ENHANCED HUMAN ODOR. RALPH CLEARED THE IMMEDIATE AREA WHERE I THEN GAVE ANOTHER LOUD AND CLEAR CANINE ANNOUNCEMENT AND WAITED. WITH NO RESPONSE I LET RALPH CONTINUING SEARCHING. RALPH WAS SEARCHING WHERE HE WAS GETTING TANGLED ON WHAT APPEARED TO BE CABINETS ON THE FLOOR. I RELEASED HIM BY TOSSING THE LEAD OVER THEM SO HE WOULD NOT GET TANGLED UP. RALPH WENT TO MY LEFT DOWN A HALLWAY WHERE I HEARD YELLING TO INDICATE TO ME RALPH HAD LOCATED AND APPREHENDED SOMEBODY INSIDE. THE TEAM PUSHED THE SMALL HALLWAY, WHERE I TURNED A CORNER INTO WHAT APPEARED IT WAS GOING TO BE A BATHROOM AND OBSERVED RALPH HAD APPREHENDED THE SUSPECT LATER IDENTIFIED AS GREGORY, BY BITING HIM ON THE UPPER RIGHT ARM INTO THE SHOULDER AREA. THE TEAM MOVED IN WHERE THEY GAINED CUSTODY OF HIS HANDS. ONCE IT WAS SAFE AND THE SUSPECT WAS IN CUSTODY, I REMOVED RALPH FROM THE SUSPECT WITH NO FURTHER INCIDENT. WITH THIS BEING THE ONLY SUSPECT SEEN ON CAMERA THE SEARCH WAS COMPLETE.

PHOENIX FIRE DEPARTMENT ARRIVED AND TREATED GREGORY FOR HIS INJURIES WHICH CONSISTED OF A DOG BITE TO THE RIGHT UPPER ARM/SHOULDER AREA. GREGORY WAS THEN PHOTOGRAPHED BY OFFICER SMOKE #8856. HE WAS THEN TAKEN BY OFFICER GARCIA #11081 TO COUNTY HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. IT SHOULD BE NOTED SERGEANT CARMODY #5634 WAS PRESENT AT THE TIME OF THE APPREHENSION.

I HAD NOR FURTHER INVOLVEMENT IN THIS INCIDENT. PLEASE SEE RELATED REPORTS FOR FURTHER DETAILS.
